


MINISTRY IN TWO DIRECTIONS

MINISTRIES INSIDE THE PARISH

Our projected budget to support our ministries for 2012-13 is approximately \$189,000. This represents an increase of about 25% in our giving.

Here are some of the ministries that we share in:



Pastoral and Teaching
This year we will provide full support for the ministry in the Canning Vale area south of Roe Highway.

Sharing in the Diocesan Mission
Like other parishes in the Diocese we contribute to a variety of diocesan ministries, including clergy training, ministries with children and young people, chaplaincies and the like.

IN PARTNERSHIP WITH THE DIOCESE

The ministry in the areas south of Roe is being conducted in partnership with the Diocese who will contribute \$20,000 to the costs this year.

MINISTRIES OUTSIDE THE PARISH

Once again we are asking you to decide how much you give both to Christ the King and to Mission Projects outside the parish. You have a choice as to whether you give to all the projects or only to some. You can find out more about the projects from the Mission Projects Leaflet or from the representative of the Project.

There are six projects which Church Council recommends:

- Bush Church Aid Society BCA
- Churches Commission on Education (Youthcare)
- Church Missionary Society CMS
- The Bible Society
- Indian Inland Mission,
- Kokstad Christian Centre

PLANNING YOUR GIVING

We are asking you to give to two different ministries:

- Christ the King
- Mission Projects

We are asking you to consider the method by which you give. We recommend:

- Bank Transfers
- Giving Envelopes

Both of these methods allow you to give thoughtfully, prayerfully, and consistently.

We are asking you to pray and consider how much you will share and to respond using the Financial Commitment Form (overleaf).

WAYS TO GIVE

It is very helpful if income comes in regularly and consistently. Last year most came through envelopes, but increasingly people are using bank transfers. Here are some suggestions about good ways to give:

Direct Debit - The Preferred Method

- You can give your bank a **Standing Order** to make a regular contribution each week, month, or quarter by filling out a standard form. You can get this form from Jay Perera.
- You can also set up a regular bank transfer through the **Pay Anyone** facility of your Internet banking. The advantage of this is that you can adjust it at any time. Our bank details are on the next page. For more information about this please speak to Dale.

Giving Envelopes

We encourage everyone who does not use bank transfers to use envelopes. The benefit is that it helps us plan our giving. And it helps us give consistently—not just when we are in church and depending on what is in our wallet/purse on the day. Jay Perera can help you with envelopes.

Cash

Cash in the plate is still fine if the above methods are not appropriate for you.

GIVING TO TWO MINISTRIES

If you use **Bank Transfers** you can complete two Standing orders, or set up two Pay Anyone payments so you can give to Church as well as Missions.

If you use **Envelopes** the new envelopes have two pockets one for Christ the King and one for Missions. You need to write which Mission Project you want to give to, otherwise it will be given to BCA (who provided our envelopes free of charge).
